



If we turn to the Ancient Aryan civilization and culture, we find the most significant and immortal products of the latter were those subtle metaphysical systems of Indian philosophy which, even though certain of their aspects are unsuited to the Occident, have never been surpassed. Later on we come to the Egyptian civilization with its specific characteristics. As the Ancient Aryans had cultivated subtle metaphysical thought, the Egyptians cultivated magic. Occultly considered, whereas the Indians had, so to say, explored the high spiritual planes, the Egyptians explored the astral plane. In their Mysteries the neophyte learned how to leave his body and experience astral consciousness. Thus the Egyptians may be termed practical occultists in contradistinction to mystics. But towards the decline of their civilization their magic deteriorated and, becoming tainted with superstition, was often employed for evil ends. Numerous souls incarnated to-day are paying off bad Karma which they generated in Egypt through the improper use of magic. We may mention en passant that so many ancient Egyptian objects are "unlucky" because impregnated with the evil magnetism resulting from such practices.

Magic is the *power* to make things happen for the common good or for selfish ends.


Seventh rule of white magic (first rule in the astral plane):

Hierarchies of Science and Knowledge




Figure 15. Today's hierarchy of science.

Self-consciousness is the most fundamental mystery of human life

- What is consciousness? How does it evolve from the sentiency of an atom to the reflective self-awareness focused on the brain of a human being?
- Does the brain precede or succeed self-consciousness?
- Does the evolution of consciousness come to an end at the human stage, or does it keep evolving into more inclusive states of consciousness? For instance, is planet Earth a conscious Being in which the human kingdom serves as its planetary brain?

Self-consciousness is the most fundamental mystery of human life

- Is time a fourth dimension of the three-dimensional space? How is the space-time continuum of modern physics related to an evolving consciousness?
- Can there be fourth- and fifth-dimensional *states of consciousness* grounded in the *cerebral* three-dimensional space?
- Can there be information without consciousness? Are quantum bits of information the substance of a *living*, *conscious* space?
- Do this "living, conscious space" explain the "magical" phenomena of "action at a distance" observed in the new world of quantum physics?

Six Conclusions from Dean Radin's Work

Based on the available scientific evidence, it is a virtual certainty that:

- Psi (psychic sense) is a genuine "sixth sense."
- Psi capacities are widely distributed among the general population.
- These effects arise from the unconscious.
- Psi effects are stronger during non-ordinary states of consciousness, such as during meditation, while dreaming, or while under the influence of psychedelic compounds.
- We have the capacity to mentally influence the physical world, probably not through
 application of the four known physical forces, but perhaps through unidentified principles
 that either affect the probabilities of events or "warp" the fabric of space-time.
- We can gain information from sources purported to be nonphysical entities.



We are entering a scientific age, but it will be a science which passes out of the impasse which it has now reached and which — having penetrated as it has into the realm of the intangible — will begin to work far more subjectively than heretofore. It will recognise the existence of senses which are super-sensory and which are extensions of the five physical senses, and this will be forced upon science because of the multitude of reliable people who will possess them and who [Page 135] can work and live in the worlds of the tangible and the intangible simultaneously. The mass of reputable testimony will be incontrovertible. The moment that the subjective world of causes is proven to exist (and this will come through the indisputable evidence of man's extended senses) science will enter a new era; its focus of attention will change; the possibilities of discovery will be immense and materialism (as that word is now understood) will vanish. Even the word "materialism" will become obsolete and men in the future will be amused at the limited vision of our modern world and wonder why we thought and felt as we did.

Real magic, driven by the spiritual will, is a science relating energy — all matter is energy — to consciousness. We are told in the book Glamour: A World Problem by AAB/DK, that "The presentation of material substance as essentially only a form of energy was as great a revelation as any given by the Christ or the Buddha... It related energy to force, form to life, and man to God and held the secret of transformation, transmutation, and transfiguration."

The magician must practice:

- 1) profound attentiveness, focusing the fiery intention,
- 2) serene expectancy or equipoise, calming the emotional waters, and
- 3) perfect adaptability in molding the etheric substance.


CONCLUSION
